Heńte?, I am Nlaka’pamux from the Skuppah Indian Band. I was born and raised in Lytton BC by John McIntyre from Lytton and May McLinden from Falls Creek. My first jobs were working for the Nlaka’pamux Tribal Council and the Fraser Canyon Tribal Administration in the mid ‘80s. After a 12 year absence to attend post-secondary schools and start a family, I returned to the community in the late ‘90s and started a career in First Nations Health.

In 2004 I completed the inaugural Aboriginal Health Care Administration Program at UBC. Before and since then I have explored courses in marketing, computers, adult instructor, water systems, and most recently, Traditional Herbal Practices at Seabird Island College with Dr. Jeanne Paul, ND. I am currently a student of Nłe?kėpmxcin and attend courses online with NVIT.

Though almost all my family live at Skuppah, my three children are in their 20’s and live in Parsnip River, Skuppah, and Nanaimo. As one of the smallest Bands in the Province, we are governed under a hereditary system, and I was appointed Councillor in 2005. I have been the Health Director for the community since 2001 and currently sit as a Board Member for Nlaka’pamux Health Services Society.

I am honoured to be the Nlaka’pamux Health Technical Representative for the 12 Bands in the territory falling within the Interior Health Region. K^wuk^wsćemx^w
